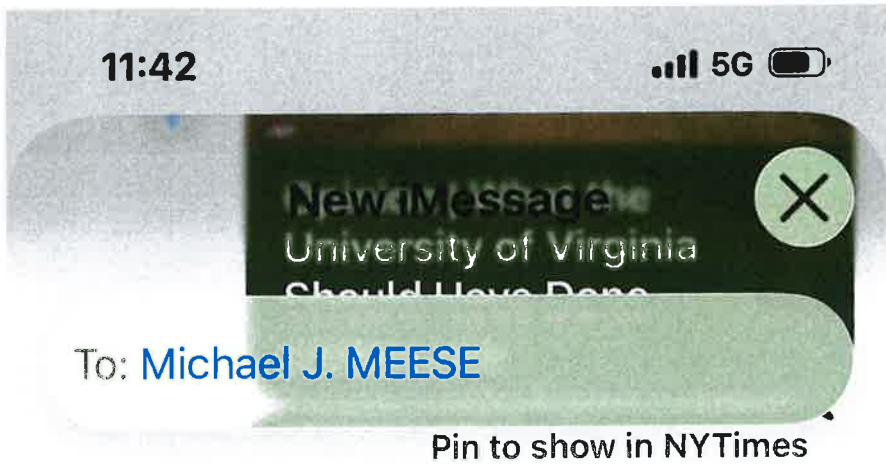

It will be interesting to see if anybody notices and if it becomes an issue.

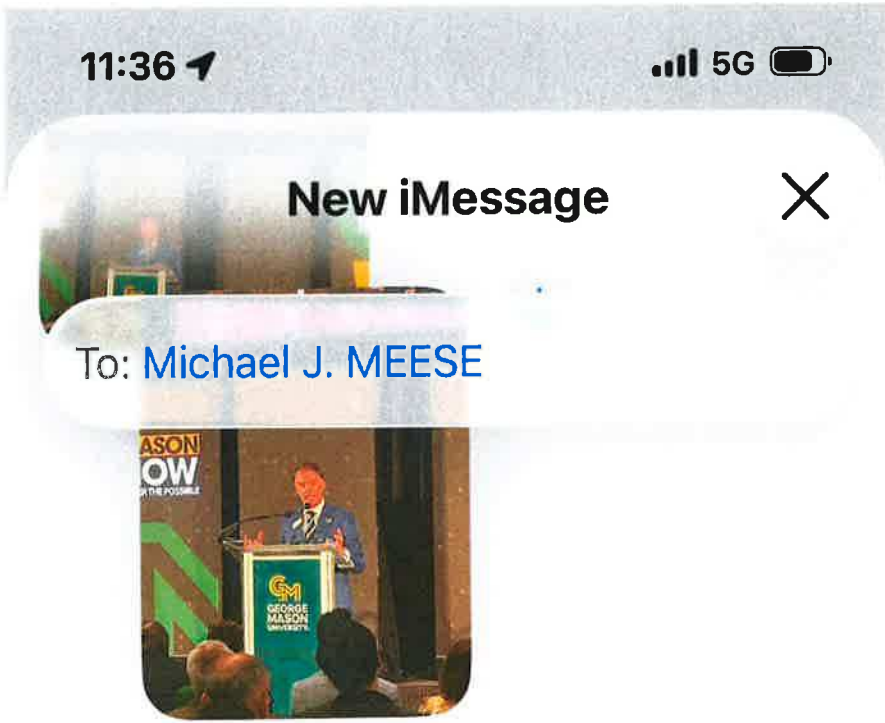
